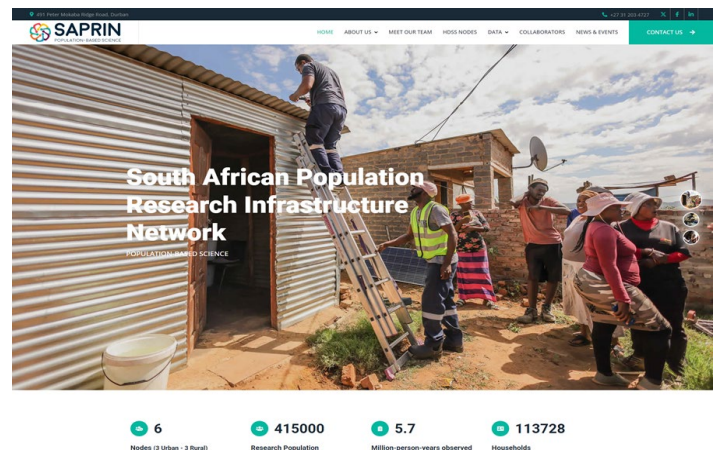


SAPRIN LAUNCHES IMPROVED WEBSITE AT PHASA CONFERENCE 2023

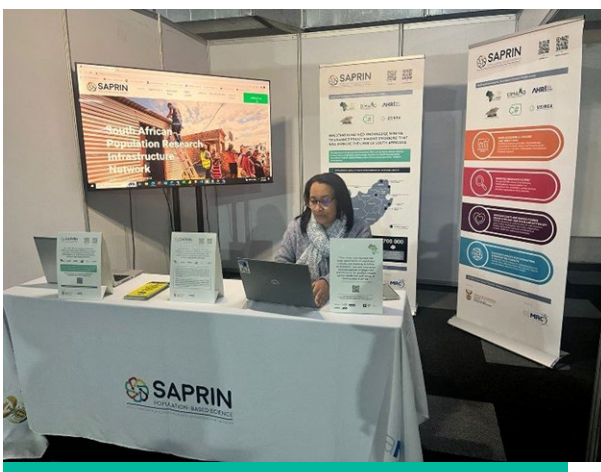

The South African Population Research Infrastructure Network (SAPRIN) is the leading Health and Demographic Surveillance System (HDSS) network in South Africa. The network collects health and demographic data in three rural nodes and three urban nodes. There are more than 415 000 individuals in the cohort and approximately 113 728 households with over 5.7-million-person years observed.



The network is a collaborative partnership between public and academic institutions aiming to produce high quality research. This makes it a valuable resource for researchers, academics, and policy makers to inform data driven decision making and improve the health of the nation. SAPRIN is hosted by the South African Medical Research Council and funded by the Department of Science and Innovation (DSI). SAPRIN is part of the DSI's strategy to build and strengthen research capacity in the country and part of the South African Research Infrastructure Roadmap (SARIR).

SAPRIN updated its website and launched the improved website at the PHASA Conference 2023 being held from the 10-13 September 2023.
