## CO-DIRECTOR

Associate Professor Mark A. Collinson serves as the Co-Director SAPRIN. In his role, Prof. Collinson ensures that the longitudinal population data is utilised as a national resource for research, training, and policy development.

Prof. Collinson is a Reader in Population and Public Health at the MRC/Wits Rural Public Health and Health Transitions Research Unit (Agincourt), within the School of Public Health, Faculty of Health Sciences at the University of the Witwatersrand.

He played a key role in establishing the MRC/Wits Agincourt Health and Demographic Surveillance System in rural Mpumalanga in 1992.

Additionally, he has led the INDEPTH Migration, Urbanisation and Health Working Group since 2003.

Prof. Collinson is the principal investigator of the Multi-Centre Analysis of the Dynamics of Internal Migration and Health (MADIMAH), a multi-country project.

He is also the co-PI of the "Migrant Health Follow-Up Study," a five-year NIH-funded project that tracks the health and economic outcomes of rural internal migrants.
